We fully support Canada Post Corporation to maintain the integrity of the Federal Government by serving the public with mail distribution. I think the Corporation is doing an excellent job serving the public in its present form and I cannot emphasize enough the need to keep the system going as a Federal Government Institution, staffed by members of the Canadian Postal Workers Union.

My own experience has been that every time I visit a Canada Post Office I receive very courteous service, the staff are very skilled at their job, and are very quick to advise the customer their options to mail a parcel in the most expedient and economical method manner.

I used to visit other commercial outlets to mail parcels and I have not had a pleasant experience. In one instance the regular mail server reported in sick that day and the alternate server did not know how to handle the mail or the customers who were lined up waiting impatiently, when the alternate called the management for backup, her pleas were ignored. I have not visited that outlet since. Our mail carriers are very pleasant and always have a smile, no one has ever given us the need to complain about service.

By observing the adage "if it aint broke dont fix it" stands true in my belief that Canada Post should keep up the good work in its present form and continued reliability
