Dear Mr. Lunn:

Again Mr. Harper and his Conservative government are functioning with no regard to the concept of the "Public Good". Or to the concept of Public Hearings. I refer to the proposal to eliminate the exclusive privilege of Canada Post to handle the country's mail.
