
RE: Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review

Please be advised that the above matter has been brought to my attention by the President of the local Canadian Union of Postal Workers indicating concern with the possible loss of service to local City of Pembroke ratepayers as well as the lack of public input into the strategic plan review.

Pembroke City Council is concerned with any action that may be taken that would have the potential to reduce the level of service to our residents and/or cause increases to postal rates. Local residents have always and continue to rely on Canada Post to provide an efficient mail delivery service at affordable rates. Any action on the part of the Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities and Minister responsible for the Canada Post Corporation which would jeopardize this, would of course be of significant concern to Pembroke City Council.

It is the expectation of the Council of the City of Pembroke that the actual owners of our post office, being the general public, be consulted and provided the opportunity to have input into the strategic plan review and any impact it may have locally. In order to achieve the goal of any public institution and the ideals of transparency and accountability, public input must be respected and adhered to in this matter. An indication that this is going to occur would be appreciated.
