As a member of the Council of Canadians, I am writing to request that our public post office not be deregulated and that Canada Post maintain its exclusive privilege to handle addressed letters.

As mail user, I am concerned by deregulation. Deregulation elsewhere has not proven to be a good thing for the public.

But most importantly, I am appalled that the review of our public post office does not include public hearings! I believe that the government should not make any decisions about our public post office until it has properly consulted with the public.
