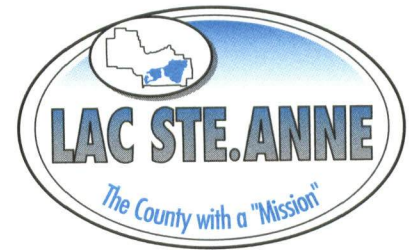

Re: Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review

Lac Ste. Anne County is a rural municipality situated in North Central Alberta. The County, as well as the businesses and residents within the County, rely heavily on our rural post offices for letter and parcel services, for both personal and business purposes. Although rates for postal services have increased slightly over the last few years, we still believe we are receiving quality and reliable service, and good value. As a municipality, legislation requires that many notices be sent to our residents and Canada Post Service serves us very well. We do not have any alternate private sector mail provider available within our municipality therefore any significant changes to the current postal service will have a detrimental effect on our County and residents.

In view of the importance of Canada Post to all Canadians we believe that the Government must hold public hearings which will provide accurate input into your consultation process.

Finally, but possibly most importantly, we strongly oppose any deregulation of our public post offices.

Please note that Lac Ste. Anne County, at their regular meeting of June 26th, 2008, resolved unanimously to forward this submission.
